SARAH VAUGHAN

Just a short time ago, Sarah Vaughan was singing in the choir at the Mount Zion Baptist Church in Newark, N.J. But now she is "The Divine Sarah"—one of the most artful of all girl vocalists. How came all this? Simple—Sarah is a great singer.

On a dare, she entered the amateur show at New York's Apollo Theatre and won first prize . . . a prize that included a week's engagement with the Earl Hines orchestra. At the end of the fateful week, Sarah was offered a perma-

nent spot with the band.

The male vocalist with Hines at that time was Billy Eckstine, and singing with the great Mr. B. was a wonderful thrill for newcomer Sarah. When Billy started his own band a year later, she went with him. When Billy dissolved his group to become a singing star single, Sarah also went out on her own. Today, both Billy and Sarah are single stars, but every once in a while they still get together and record a great duet.
