SARAH VAUGHAN 1949 - 1950

olumbia records seized the opportunity and produced highly varied sessions with Sarah Vaughan, Basically she was a pure jazz singer - and definitely one of the very best in the business. The major record company realized. however, that her magnificent voice also had the potential to attract a clientele who otherwise cared little for jazz. In addition, Columbia also organized sympathetic backing bands of jazz musicians for Sarah Vaughan, Both of these facets are well documented on the enclosed tracks.

Sarah Lois "Sassy" Vaughan was born in Newark, New Jersey, on March 27, 1924. The daughter of a religious family. she took piano and organ lessons and began singing in the Mount Zion Baptist Church Choir in her hometown. In spring 1943, she sang at the Wednesday Night Amateur contest at the "Apollo" in Harlem. After hearing her rendition of "Body & Soul", Billy Eckstine, who was singing with Earl Hines's band at the time recommended her to the leader who offered her a job as second planist and vocalist with his orchestra. In 1943, Hines' big band featured Dizzy Gillespie, Charlie Parker and several other musicians who became towering figures of bebop. It is highly regrettable for the history of jazz that no studio recordings could be made during that period. In 1944, Sarah Vaughan joined Billy Eckstine's new big band with whom she was finally able to make her first recording. Over the next two years, Sarah Vaughan was able to wax some of her finest vocals, often in the company of young, creative musicians. Her sessions with Parker, Gillespie and Tadd Dameron belong to the most influential vocal records since Billie Holiday's late-thirties sessions with Teddy Wilson. Sarah Vaughan became one of the greatest stars in the business and recorded with the finest bands in America. From the fifties onwards, she also worked with string accompaniments and made many rather commercial recordings. However, Sarah Vaughan never gave up singing with jazz bands, including many successful studio and concert appearances with Count Basie's big band. In 1951, she visited Europe for the first time, Over the next decades, her fame and reputation allowed her to travel extensively. Her vocal artistry has fortunately been preserved on hundreds of live and studio recordings. "The Divine" Sarah Vaughan died in Hidden Hills, California, on April 3, 1990.

Volume four of the complete recordings of Sarah Vaughan presented in chronological order, opens with a fine session from December 1949. "You're Mine You" and "The Nearness Of You" showcase her inimitable voice in the company of a studio band that included several great artists although they get very little solo space. The next day Sarah Vaughan recorded alongside (singer and valve-trombonist) Billy Eckstine, who had been her first employer and mentor. The four light-hearted tracks cannot be compared with the hot and boppish music both Eckstine and Sarah Vaughan had made a few years earlier, but they nevertheless include lovely moments. Lush and entangling sounds aimed at a clientele who quite likely were not familiar with the music both artists had made for the "De Luxe" label (see Classics 914)! limmy Jones was in charge of the band that backed Sarah Vaughan on two consecutive days in May 1950. A look at the personnel already hints at the quality of the resulting music: "Mean To Me" and "East Of The Sun", two tracks she had already recorded at the outset of her career for small labels (see Classics 958), get a new and highly original treatment. The remaining tracks of this CD once again have her backed by rather commercially oriented studio bands. To be
