Sarah is featured with three different groups. The first is a Jazz setting of Jaki Byard,
piano, Zoot Sims, Jenor Sax, Clark Jerry, trumpet, flugelhorn and vocal, Milt hinton,
bass, and Alan Dawton, drams

The second setting is with a big band of youngsters from the University of Illinois.

Arrangements are by Benny Carter.

Lastly, Serah closes, singing with an unbown Gospel group and a Disteland Band on "A Closer Walk With Thee". This track alone is worth the price of the album. Some other memorable moments are her seat singing with Clark Terry on "Sometimes I'm happy, along with Zoot sims on tenne, as well as her classic versions of "Tenderly" and "With".
