this recording, she can carry it through from beginning to end without ever disrupting that setting. In this album, Sarah takes us to the lonely hours with an assist from Benny Carter's deft and varied instrumentations. Never intruding but always enhancing the mood, Benny Carter's arrangements compliment Sarah's emotional interprotation of the lonely hours.
